BIG "G" AWARD: Complete requirements 1-6	X=Don
1. *SPL met with Commissioner <b>3 of 5</b> days (M-F) for daily program coordination	
2. *Earned GOOD or EXCELLENT ratings on Campsite Inspection at least 3 out of 5 days.	
3. *Attended OPENING (Sunday) and CLOSING (Friday) CAMPFIRE Program	
4. *Completed a camp improvement project approved by a Commissioner before or while attending camp. (see Commissioner for project list or recommend one)	
5. *Troop coordinated and completed at least one act of service <b>for another unit</b> during the week	
6. *Troop showed <b>Scout Spirit</b> by giving their <b>Troop/Patrol Cheer or Song</b> during gathering at flag ceremonies and campfires	
BIG "G" SILVER AWARD: Complete Requirements 1-13	
7. *SPL met with Commissioner <b>4 of 5</b> days (M-F) for daily program coordination	
8. *Earned <b>GOOD</b> or <b>EXCELLENT</b> ratings on Campsite Inspection at least <b>4 out of 5 days</b> .	
9. *Attended at least <b>two evening programs</b> (ex: Geronishow, Mogollon Monster Story, Commissioner Campfire, etc.) in addition to opening/closing campfires	
10. *SPL with Commissioner held at least 1 "Field Uniform" (Class A) inspection (in campsite or before flag ceremonies in the assembly area)	
11. All First Year Scouts completed 75% of the "I Did it All" challenge OR completed Brown Sea Island	
12. *Troop flag or other Troop identifying symbol was taken to all flag ceremonies (can create one at camp)	
13. Troop participated in at least one hike at camp. (Levi Young, Night-Eyes Compass Course, Geocache, Rainbow Trails, Totem to Totem)

BIG "G" GOLD AWARD: Complete Requirements 1-22	
14. *SPL met with Commissioner <b>5 of 5</b> days (M-F) for daily program coordination	
15. *Earned <b>EXCELLENT</b> ratings on <b>4 of 5</b> daily Campsite Inspections	
16. Troop participated as a unit in at least 1 Polar Bear Swim (if offered)	
17. *Led a flag ceremony as a troop for the whole camp at the main assembly area, or in your campsite; and flew and American Flag each day in your campsite	
18. *Coordinated with Commissioner and completed a <b>conservation related project at camp</b> during the week (erosion, trash clean-up, trail maintenance, etc.)	
19. Invited Unit Commissioner or other Staff Member to sit with them during a meal or evening troop program	
20. *SPL discussed with Camp/Program Director, or Head Commissioner, the "Goods, Betters, and Bests" of camp, and recommended any improvements	
21. *All Patrols had a Patrol Flag or other identifying symbol and took them to the Flag Ceremonies at least 4 days during the week (can be created at camp)	
22. *Retired at least one American Flag (if campfires were allowed) and presented grommets to a Commissioner for inclusion in the USS Arizona Bell Project

At least 1 Adult Leader completed the AED/CPR certification class (See Scoutmaster Program)	
At least ½ of the adults present <b>completed 3 or more events</b> of the "Scoutmasters Program" in addition to Sun/Fri Scoutmaster meetings and Executive Luncheon	
Adults Leaders assisted in a Program area (Brownsea Island, Rifle Range, Nature Lodge, etc.) OR assisted with main dining hall KP duties for at least 2 meals

SCOUT OATH (PLC Self-evaluation of HOW WE DID during the week at Camp Geronimo)	Points
<b>Duty to God</b> (Daily remembrance of a Scout's Duty to God through an inspirational or spiritual activity, <b>Scout's Own activity</b> ; follow own beliefs). (0-5 points)	
<b>Duty to Country</b> (Troop campsite flag ceremonies, Geronimo Flag Ceremonies, Singing/learning patriotic songs, patriotic storytelling). (0-5 points)	
To keep myself mentally awake: Curious to learn new things from leaders and instructors. Allowed everyone to get adequate rest. (0-5 points)	
To help other people at all times. Example of Scout Slogan. Searched for or did not bypass opportunities to serve others. (0-5 points)	
To keep myself physically strong: Participation in physical activities; eat healthy foods; got enough sleep; avoid things that cause harm to body. (0-5 points)	
To keep myself morally straight: Defended rights of others; practiced Scout Values, honest and open with others. (0-5 points)	
THE SCOUT LAW Circle points of the Scout Law that your troop excelled in. Discuss the ones that need improvement. (Points = the number of circles)	
Trustworthy Loyal Helpful Friendly Courteous Kind Obedient Cheerful Thrifty Brave Clean Reverent (12 points max)	
THE OUTDOOR CODE	
Did our best to set the example for our Scouts and other troops on how to care for nature. (0-5 points)	
Clean in my outdoor manners: Left no trace that we were there; cleaned/removed our trash and any we found. (0-5 points)	
Careful with fire: Fires ONLY where permitted; fire was completely out when done; evidence of our fires removed; no playing with fire (0-5 points)	
<b>Considerate in the outdoors:</b> Ethical in my treatment of the land; kept voices down to respect wildlife and during presentations by instructors/leaders, pointed out and avoided poisonous plants; respected animal habitat—did not disturb/harm nature. (0-5 points)	
Conservation Minded: Stayed on established trails; did not trample/break trees and plants; planned and got permission to do a conservation project. (0-5 points)	
SCOUT MOTTO: BE PREPARED. Rate your troop's preparedness from arrival on your week's experiences. Fully prepared, or how could we improve? (0-5 points)	
SCOUT SLOGAN: Circle days your troop did a good turn for another unit/person. 1 point for each circle: Sun Mon Tue Wed Thu Fri (6 points max)
